**INSTITUTION:** Dignity College of Healthcare

**BASIS FOR EXEMPTION:** Under **\$2500** - Education Code section 94874(f)

The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) has completed the review of your Institution's Application for Verification of Exempt Status pursuant to the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (Act) based on the application received on October 7, 2024.

The application demonstrates that Dignity College of Healthcare has met the qualifications for exemption from regulation under the Act, pursuant to California Education Code (CEC) section 94874(f): "*...educational program for total charges of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or less when no part of the total charges is paid from state or federal student financial aid programs*".

Pursuant to CEC §94874.7, this verification of exemption shall remain valid until October 21, 2026, as long as the institution maintains full compliance with the requirements of this exemption. Any of the following conditions will deem the institution ineligible for this exemption:

- any part of the total charges are paid from state or federal student financial aid programs;
- the institution awards a degree; or
- the institution is approved to participate in veterans' financial aid programs pursuant to Section 21.4253 of Title 38 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Additionally, exempt institutions shall comply with CEC §94927.5 regarding the retention of student records and transcripts and their submission to the Bureau prior to closing.
